Since the onset of this virus, we have had 81 residents and 19 staff members test positive for COVID-19. Per CDC guidelines, we are continuing to test all employees weekly and have do not have any confirmed positive employees or residents at this time.

We are continuing to do outside visitation, as weather permits, by appointment. Please call Annie Burns, Activities Director at the number below if you would like to schedule a time.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

WEEKLY UPDATE

January 22, 2021

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 81 residents and 20 staff members test positive for COVID-19. Although we continue not to have any residents who have tested positive since May of 2020, we did have one employee test positive on Tuesday of this week. That employee was sent home to self-quarantine for 14 days. We tested all residents on the following Wednesday, with no confirmed positives. We will test all residents again next week and are currently testing all employees twice a week per CDC guidelines, as Richland County's positivity rate is now over 10%.

We have currently suspended outdoor visitation until February 3rd, 2021 as we are required to do so for 14 days after a staff member tests positive. We will resume outdoor visitation at that time.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 81 residents and 20 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We are continuing to perform surveillance testing on all employees twice weekly and have had no new confirmed positives. All of our residents continue to be asymptomatic, however, as a precaution we are testing all residents today. We will continue to keep you informed of all testing results.

We will resume outside visitation by appointment next week, so if you would like to schedule a time, please call Annie Burns, Activities Director, at the number below. Also, we had our second COVID 19 vaccine clinic yesterday and made the first or second dose, as appropriate, available to all residents and employees. We will be scheduled for another clinic in approximately 30 days.
