Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,


Please accept this letter as Midlands Health and Rehab's weekly update to keep you informed about the status of COVID in our facility and what our facility is doing to keep our residents and staff safe during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

There have been no additional confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility since our last update. Of the 70 residents and 22 staff members that tested positive, all have resolved with the exception of 2. We retested those residents last week and are awaiting the results. We tested 83 employees on May 18th, 2020 and **ALL** came back negative. To insure we maintain the significant progress we have made, we are continuing to restrict visitation as well as keep our isolation policies in effect. We have continued daily room to room activities and as part of our Memorial Day observation we supported our local community by sending out for barbeque for all of our residents! It was well received and enjoyed by all.

We remain committed to preventing further spread of this virus throughout our community, and as we previously reported, we will continue to implement and practice enhanced safety precautions recommended by our federal, state and local health officials, such as, only allowing essential personnel inside the facility, performing regular screenings for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering the building, continually monitoring residents, performing regular deep cleanings, using PPE as recommended by the CDC, providing individual activities as opposed to group activities, implementing isolation protocols as required, and reminding and encouraging staff to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community.

As a reminder, we will continue to post updates on our facility website and we will individually notify representatives/families regarding a resident's condition if he/she tests positive for COVID-19 or is displaying symptoms of COVID-19. June 10, 2020

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

As of today, Midlands Health and Rehab (MHR) is a COVID-19 free facility! Our resident that previously tested positive was retested and we learned today the test result is negative. I would like to say “thank you” for a job well done to our staff, who have continuously cared for our residents during this difficult period. They truly exemplify the sentiment of our new banner out front which proudly reads, “Hero’s Work Here”!

We must remain diligent in our efforts to prevent the spread of COVID-19, so our staff continues to practice the enhanced safety precautions we have previously reported to you through our website and we are closely monitoring the recommendations of our federal, state and local health officials regarding all aspects COVID-19 from mass testing to visitation recommendations.

In fact, as South Carolina continues to loosen COVID-19 restrictions throughout the state, many people are asking when they will be able to visit their loved ones. At this time, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (“CMS”), the Centers for Disease Control (“CDC”) and our state health officials still recommend we restrict social visitation and only allow essential personnel in the facility. Please understand these restrictions are in place to reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19 in our facility and to keep our residents safe.

We understand how difficult it has been to not see and visit your loved ones over the past several months and we appreciate your patience and understanding during this time. Until it is safe to allow visitors, please remember that we encourage you to stay in touch with your loved ones through FaceTime, emails, letters and phone calls. Please let us know if you are having trouble connecting with your loved one and we will be more than happy to facilitate your communication.

Please remember to check our website for updates. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
